# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

#### Do I need to register for this event?

Registration is required for this event. Teachers need to register students directly by completing the JA Inspire Request Form or by contacting JA staff. Marianne Lanspa, Program Manager can be emailed at Programs@jasac.org.

Parents/Guardians, independent learners and any other community members wanting to participate, simply follow the "Register Now" link at the top of the page and submit your information. Then you'll receive an email confirming your registrations.

#### Who is this event for?

The event is for all students in 6th - 12th grades ready to explore and/or deepen their knowledge of varying career paths.

#### What can students expect at JA Inspire?

Students will learn about career opportunities in our region and across the nation, by viewing videos and content provided by participating companies and organizations across many career clusters.

#### Where will the event be held?

This is an in classroom event; no transportation needed! Teachers will be sent log-in information and instructions after registration.

### Do I need to download or install any information to be able to attend this event?

No. You do not need to download or install any software to participate. You only need to have access to the internet.

#### Is a webcam required?

No, we are not allowing students or other participants to be on camera.

#### How do I log in?

If you are a registered educator or student, go to: JAInspireSacramento.vfairs.com between January 1 - May 15, 2024:

- Click the "login" button.
- If you are a student, use the username that your teacher or JA staff provided you to login. No password is required.
- If you have not registered for the event, scroll to the top of this page and click the "Register Now" button.

#### When and how often can you visit JA Inspire?

Educators, students and their parents may visit JA Inspire anytime 24/7, as many times as they like, between January 1 - May 15, 2024. You can save files and store them in your virtual backpack during this time. Files may also be sent to a provided email.

#### Is this a hiring event?

No, this event is specifically geared to career exploration and college and career readiness. Students will only be able to ask questions to local businesspeople through the optional, secure Q&A feature. This gives them the opportunity to take a deeper dive into the various careers within the 16 career clusters.

#### What information will be collected about each student?

Student information is never shared by JA or vFairs. Each student will have a unique login for the virtual event; however, it does not need to contain any personal information. If a student chooses, they may enter an email address to download materials provided by the attending companies.
